

Gallup Gallop FAQ Sheet

Updated 5-6-17

Where is the race?	The event is held in Ann Arbor's Gallup Park on Geddes Road. (The entrance is just west of Huron Parkway.)
Where can I park?	There is some parking in the park, and more across the street on the grass, and if need be also at Huron High School.
Is there day of race registration?	Yes. This is from 7:15 – 8:30 AM.
What time do the races start?	The 1 mile starts at 8:30 AM and the 5K at 9 AM.
Where are the starting lines?	They are both the same – on the park road near the bridge. (~ 1/8 of a mile from the park buildings near the entrance.)
What/where is the 5K course?	The course is basically just under 2 laps around the park. (Most of the course is paved, but part of it is on wood chips)
What/where is the 1 mile course?	It is an out and back that starts at the 5K start line and finishes back just before the canoe livery. (It's all paved.)
Can I run with a child in the mile? (as a non-registered runner)	Yes. (As long as you let the child win!)
Is there a special category for walkers?	No, they start along with the runners at the back of the pack.
Are there aid stations on the course?	Yes, there is one at the ~1.5 mile mark.
Are there bathrooms on the course?	Yes, in the park headquarters buildings.
Can I run with a stroller?	Yes, but please be careful and courteous to other runners.
Can I run with a dog?	Sorry, we don't allow dogs.
When are the awards given out?	As soon after the race as possible, usually around 10 AM.
Are their results for the Mile?	No, it's a fun run. But there will be a clock at the finish line.
Are their results for the 5K?	Yes – they are posted in the park & on-line as soon as possible.
What do I do if the shirts ran out?	You will either get a \$5 discount, or you can sign up to get one after the race. (We'll need a certain number to place an order)
Why did the race move to September?	Two reasons – first the park construction in 2017. Also their summery livery business was so busy the park didn't really want us interfering with that. We hope September works out!
